Sixth Day

"God made all kinds of wild <u>animals</u>...., and all kinds of <u>creeping</u> things....

And God saw how good it was. God created _____ man___ in his image,

in the divine image God created him, ____male__ and ___female__

God created them....God looked at everything he had made, and

found it was very good."

Discuss how creation continues with each new day and the birth of each new living thing. Also discuss the responsibility of humans to protect creation. Talk about the importance of the seventh day being a day of rest.
