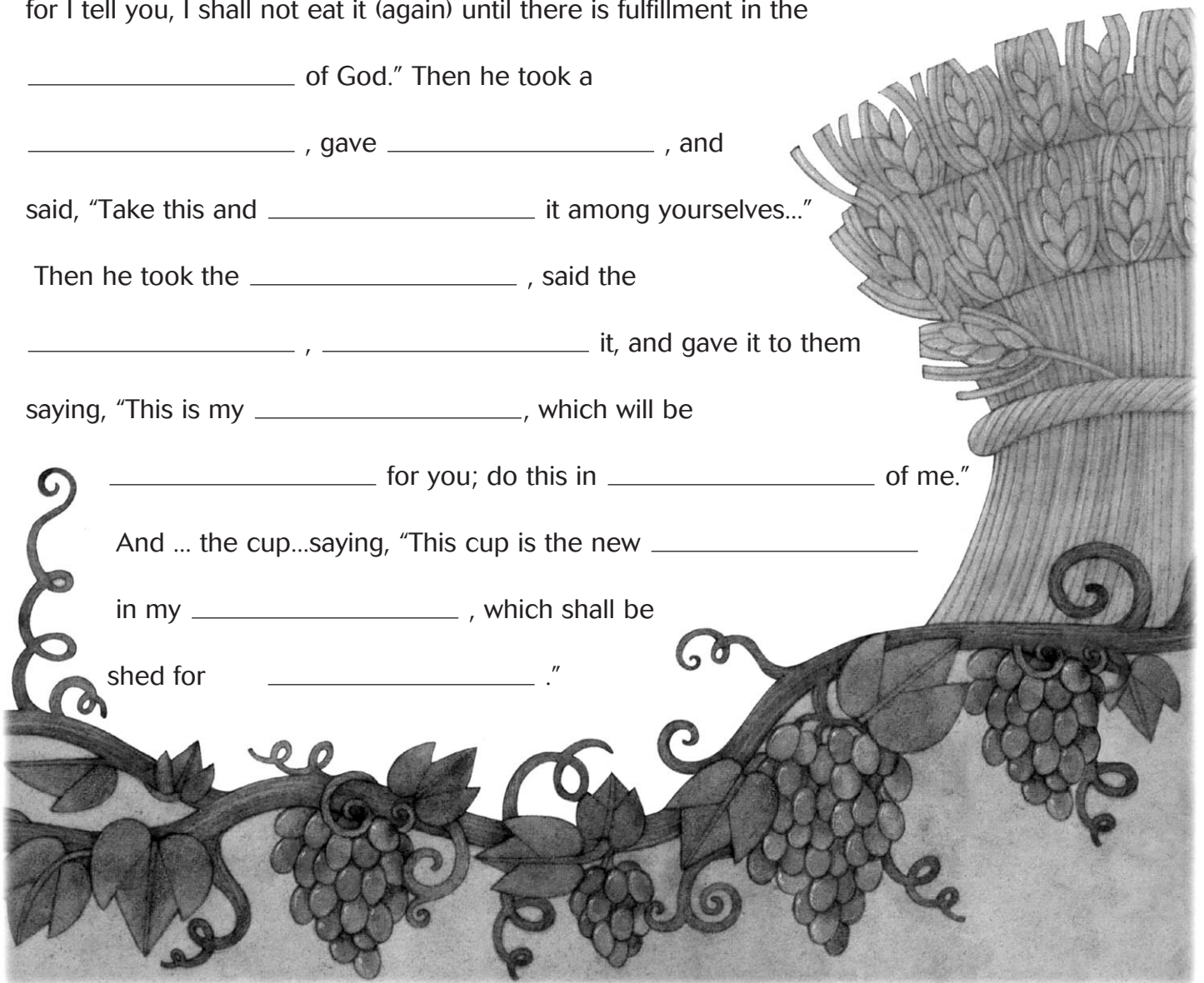

blessing, broke it, and gave it to them

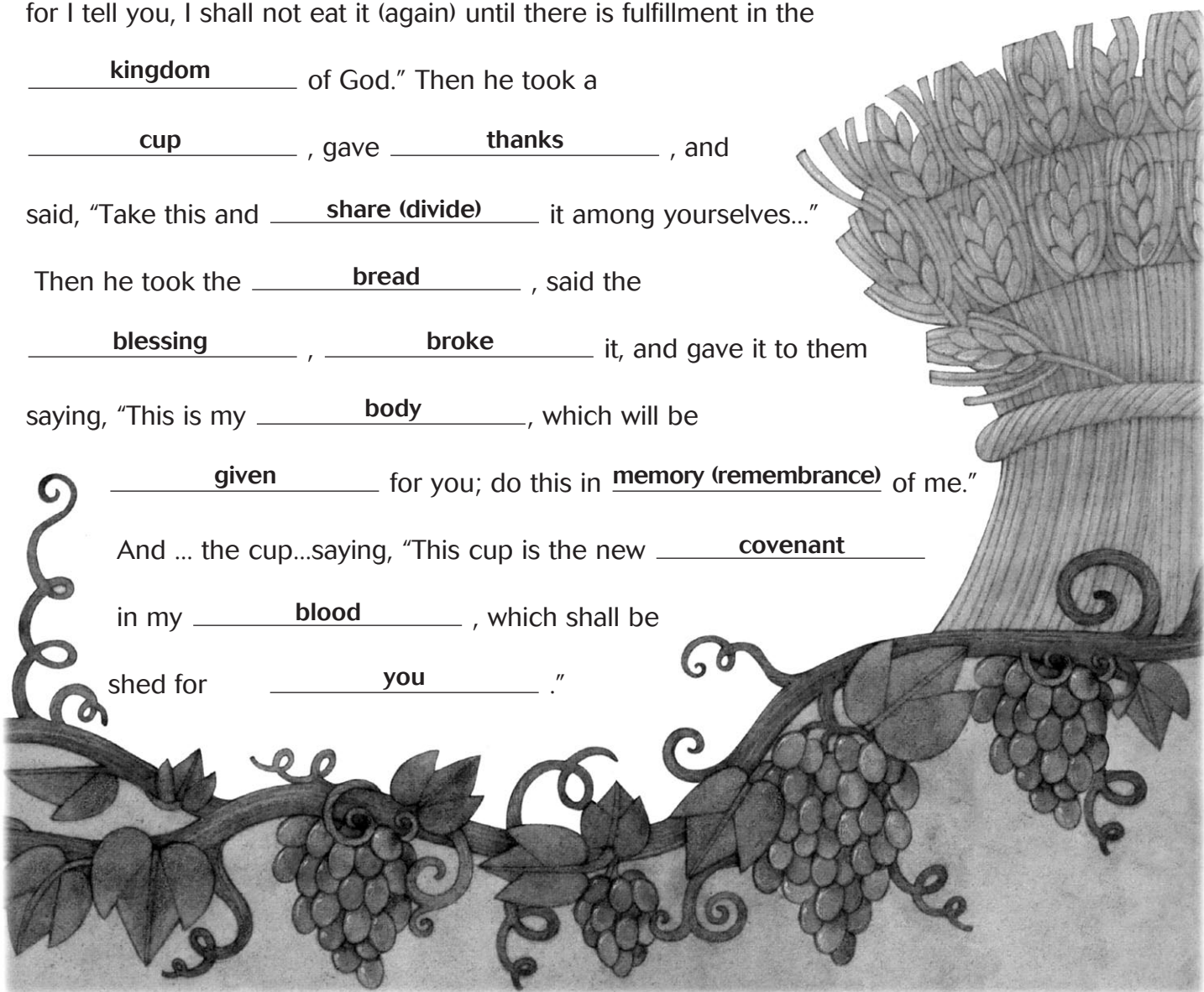
saying, "This is my body, which will be
