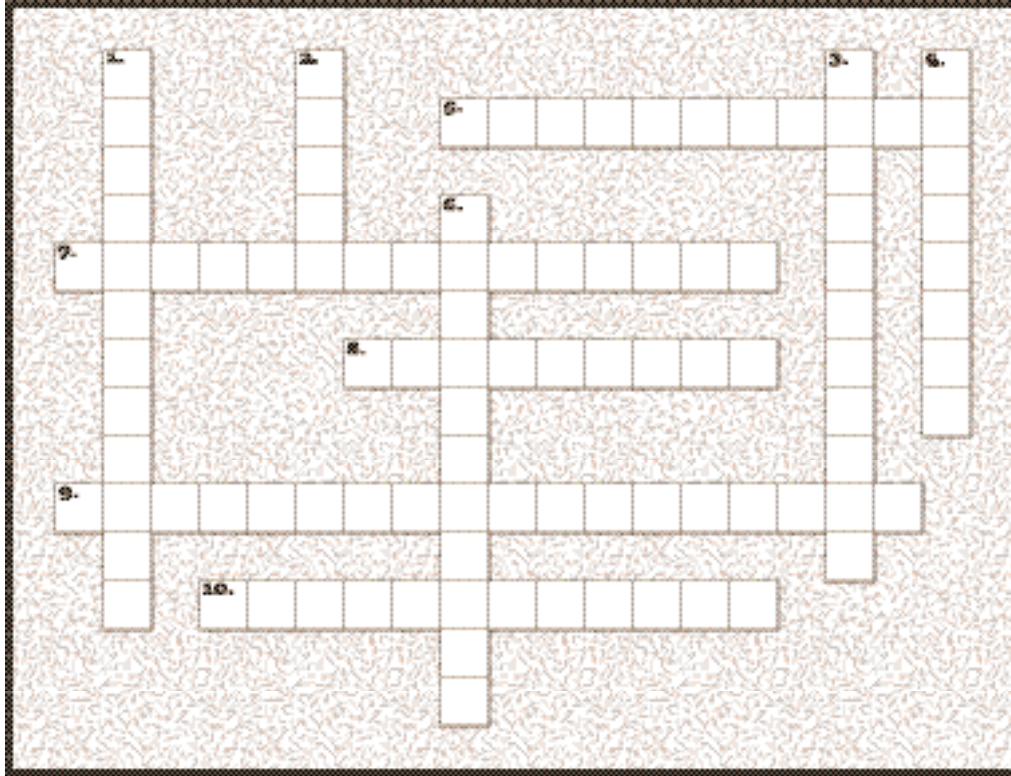


# People of the Kingdom
